BACKGROUND OF THE SCHOOL

The school for Exceptional Child is located at Roche Caiman, adjacent to Plaisance Secondary school. It started in 1977, the new school at Roche Caiman opened in 1994. Being the only specialized school in Seychelles, the students are not zoned but are drawn from districts all over the island.

The school caters for primary and prevocational level of students with sensory and/or physical impairment, intellectual and multiple disabilities. It consists of 12 basic academic classes and 5 prevocational classes namely TE, the Arts, sewing, carpentry and agriculture.

It has a total of 67 students. Generally students are classed according to their disabilities. Most classes have between 4 to 8 pupils of mixed ages and disabilities and as such their needs are different. Other services available are physical education, Occupational Therapy, Speech Therapy, Physiotherapy and music. The school has a total of 39 staff members.

THE MISSION OF THE SCHOOL

The mission of the school for the Exceptional Child is to promote independency of students in social and daily living skills in order to live a happy and enjoyable life.

VISION OF THE SCHOOL

The school for the Exceptional Child will develop and maintain a strong partnership with parents and other stakeholders.

AIMS:- My aim is to make sure that the students receive their tablet as a donation for their education.
